Terms and Conditions of entering the 2024 Perthshire Classic Car Tour

The Perthshire Classic Car Tour – ***The Tour*** is organised by The Rotary Club of Perth – ***The Organisers***

Car Eligibility

All vintage, historic and classic cars, including modern sports cars are eligible. The Organisers reserve the right to reject any car for entry to The Tour.

Driving Behaviour

As the route of The Tour will be on public A and B class and unclassified roads, participants must always comply with the requirements of the various Road Traffic Acts and drive in a responsible and considerate manner, remembering other road users, cyclists, walkers and livestock.

Participants must comply with instructions from The Organisers during the period of The Tour.

Qualification/Licences

The Tour is not a driving competition or a race and therefore no special qualifications are required. A full current UK driving licence is required for every person driving the participating car. It is the responsibility of the named driver on the entry form to check that every person driving the participating car has a full current UK driving licence.

Insurance

Insurance is the sole responsibility of the named driver on the entry form and a minimum of Third-Party insurance is required for every driver who will drive the participating car for the duration of the event.

Scrutineering

The participating car must be taxed, have a MOT certificate (if applicable) and a Certificate of Insurance. By accepting the Terms and Conditions on the Entry Form, the named driver accepts on his/her behalf and on behalf of any other driver of the participating car, that neither The Organisers (including any officials and volunteers thereof), nor any organisers of The Tour personally, shall be held liable in respect of any matter, delictual or otherwise, arising directly or indirectly from The Tour or anything incidental thereto.

Data Protection and Privacy Policy

Your personal information is important. Information obtained will be held on computer and retained as stated in our Privacy Policy and in accordance with UK legislation on GDPR.

All photographs and footage of The Tour, its participants and participating vehicles, and any other persons or vehicles attending The Tour, may be used by The Organisers for future PR and communications. Cancellation of Entry

If you have to cancel your entry, any payment made for hospitality will be refunded up to 28 days before The Tour and after this date at the discretion of The Organisers. Donations cannot be refunded.
